



PFBA Code of Conduct for Social Media

Member Qualification

The services are designed for individuals 13 years of age or older.

As a user of the service you will uphold this code of conduct and are responsible for all activities and content you post/upload.

In addition to upholding this code of conduct, you are responsible for adhering to all applicable local and national laws.

The following will automatically mean a ban:-

Abuse towards other members, admins or third parties.

Racist, sexist or disability abuse.

Direct threats.

Promoting illegal behaviour.

Please do not place any links on the wall to sites that contain malicious code or promote anything against our own code of conduct, these will be removed. If you're unsure on a link, ask an admin.

No Flooding.

Flooding is when you post the same comment or post repeatedly on the wall, including non-relevant posts. These will be deleted including the original.

We will not allow:

Personal attacks - Name calling, insults and degradation of another member. This includes questioning their competence.

Flaming - Aggressive and attacking posts that go after another member.

Trolling - Deliberately setting out to start an argument with obvious inflammatory remarks.

This is not an exhaustive list, anything deemed offensive and/or abusive can be removed by an admin who believes it contravenes the rules.

Prohibited Uses

Incites, advocates or expresses pornography, obscenity, vulgarity, profanity, hatred, bigotry, racism, or gratuitous violence.

Threatens, stalks, defames, defrauds, degrades, victimizes or intimidates an individual or group of individuals for any reason; including on the basis of age, gender, disability, ethnicity, sexual orientation, race or ammunition or firearms.

Contains or could be considered 'junk mail', 'spam', 'chain letters', 'pyramid schemes', 'affiliate marketing', or unsolicited commercial advertisement.
